

Whether you're continuing from Year 11 at Ferndown Upper or joining us from another school, this is your chance to build on your achievements, explore new opportunities and shape your future.

At Ferndown Sixth Form, we'll support and challenge you to reach your full potential. Through UniFrog, you'll explore university courses, apprenticeships and career pathways, helping you plan your next steps with confidence. You'll also attend the UCAS Discovery Fair in Bournemouth to discover post-18 options and opportunities. Students with a GCSE point score of 7.5 or above can join our Oxbridge Programme, designed to stretch and inspire you through admissions guidance, interview preparation and super-curricular activities.



You'll gain real-world experience through a week of work experience in July, a mock interview day during Careers Week, and ongoing mentoring with your tutor to guide your decisions. We also provide tailored support for those exploring degree apprenticeships.

To ensure families are part of the journey, we offer parent workshops on using UniFrog and supporting post-18 choices at home.






# **T-Level in Software Development**




Take your firsts step to entering software development or digital careers. We are proudly Dorset and BCP's first T-level provider and are proud of our 100% pass rate at Merit and Distinction for all of our students to date.

Equivalent to three A-levels you spend your time focused on developing your skills and knowledge in your chosen area alongside general work skills development, mentoring sessions and presentations from external providers and work experience.



A compulsory 315 employer facing hours form part of the course, at Ferndown we do this as a 9 week employer placement. Our dedicated T-Level Manager will find and support you through the placement process, something most other T-level providers do not do. We have established links with companies such as JP Morgan, NHS, BAE, Curtiss Wright, Nourish Care and Telesoft to name but a few.


