The Foundation Studies course is free for those aged 18 at the start of the course in September and all students receive a free art kit and sketchbook on joining as well as a dedicated studio space and open access to a range of facilities across the Art & Technology area.

We also run a subsidised residential visit each year to London, where over the course of four days, we try and see 15-18 exhibitions of internationally renowned Art, Craft and Design. Not only so that students are inspired and informed by what they see, but we use the visit as a starting point for a project that they can directly reference when they go for interviews.

An Exploratory phase that consists of six projects, where experimentation and skill development are key, leading to pathway investigation, application and portfolio preparation.

Then onto a Confirmatory phase, where students devise their own Final Major Project, exhibit to the public and are summatively assessed as Pass, Merit or Distinction.
